Hi Gavin,

Following up my phone call just now, as discussed, our process team for the application meet this morning. While the team feels comfortable with the application and appropriately working through any critical issues, the type of activity does require public notification. A licence, if approved, will act as an exclusive occupation and therefore does require to be publicly notified. I will action the required re-tasking of the application today, however, nothing will occur until after the 10th January 2022.

Under the Conservation Act a term of up to 30 years can be considered. The application as it stands is for a term of 10 years, the applicant may want to reconsider this in light of the information regarding public notification. If you could please confirm if that is the case.
