This database has been collated to help you find information and help so you can protect kiwi. It is available as a handout at Department of Conservation and other agency offices. Wendy Sporle, BNZ Save the Kiwi National Mentor for Advocacy (kiwendi@xtra.co.nz) has been compiled it for you. She is available to provide kiwi planning and advocacy advice to kiwi projects. As new resources are developed they are promoted on the BNZ Save the Kiwi website. www.savethekiwi.org.nz At time of writing the website is being updated so detailed links have not been provided.

Most of the resources in the table are created by BNZ Save the Kiwi or found on it's web site. Also; DOC offices have information on pest control, Regional Councils usually have trapping handouts and the NZ Landcare Trust may have a representative in your region (see www.landcare.org.nz/trust/staff.asp.) These people have expertise in setting up projects and finding funding for landcare projects and provide a service as information brokers.
