These snail species were among those collected in pitfall-flight-intercept traps in the East Coast/Hawke's Bay region in the summers of 2003/04 to 2005/06. They represent a small sample of the (probably) 2000 species occurring in New Zealand,

of which only about 500 have been named. It is thought that New Zealand may have 3-5 times the snail diversity of most other countries in the world, when calculated on a per unit area basis.

Names such as 'Punctidae SPP2K n. sp. 50' refer to the 'Species 2000 List' of currently unnamed species.
