

Land Snails from the Wellington Region

These snail species were collected in pitfall-flight-intercept traps in the Wellington region in the summers of 2003/04 to 2005/06. The diversity shown is only about half of that found. They represent a small sample of the (probably) 2000 species occurring in New Zealand, of which only about 500 have been named. It is thought that New Zealand may have 3–5 times the snail diversity of most other countries in the world, when calculated on a per unit area basis. Names such as 'Punctidae SPP2K n. sp. 50' refer to the 'Species 2000 List' of currently unnamed species.
