Alpine lizards (skinks and geckos) have recently been discovered in the Nelson lakes area. We need your help to better understand their distribution and ecology.



The 'Cupola basin gecko' has only been seen twice: once in Cupola basin in the Travers valley, and the other in the Sabine valley. 'Black-eyed geckos' have also been seen in the alpine zone of Nelson lakes.
