OFFICE HOURS: 7:30am to 8:00pm. Gates close from 9pm - 7am. If you need to leave/arrive during these hours please let the camp hosts know.

CIVIL DEFENCE/TSUNAMI ALARM: In the unlikely event of a civil emergency siren, tsunami siren or earthquake evacuate immediately to tsunami evacuation zone on foot.

BEHAVIOUR/NOISE: Excessive drinking and parties are not permitted. Complete quietness is required from 10:00pm to 7:00am. Generators, loud music and machinery are also prohibited. This includes running vehicles to charge batteries. If you are experiencing a problem with excessive noise or unreasonable behaviour then please advise the camp host immediately. *Tomorrow is too late!* There is a night bell at the entrance to the camp host's private area.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR EVICTIONS

CHECKOUT: Please be off your site by 11am. If you would like to stay in the area longer please move your vehicle to the overflow carpark, or Picnic Bay.

LIQUOR ON SITE: We ask that all drinking of alcohol is restricted to your own site, not on the beach or in other places in the campsite.

VEHICLES: Please keep your vehicle speed to a walking pace and take extra care when reversing. There are always children about. Please ensure children ride their bikes at reasonable speed in the same direction as traffic.

VISITORS: Your visitors are welcome. They must register at the office BEFORE entering the camp and must leave by 9:00pm.

WATER: Do not connect any hoses to the campground water supply & take care to conserve water. Please limit use of water to clean boats.

SITE ALLOCATION: Please leave a 3-metre gap between your group and the neighbouring group, and stick to your allocated site. Maximum of 8 people per campsite. No unoccupied tents, caravans or motorhomes are allowed overnight. Please inform the camp hosts if you need to leave suddenly.

WASTE MANAGEMENT: No fish cleaning or food waste to be disposed of at the water points. Wastewater can be spread around plantings. Please don't put meat or fish into compost bins. General waste must be in grey WDC bags available at the office. Recycling is also available.

PLEASE DO NOT EMPTY TOILET WASTE OR OTHER MATERIAL INTO CAMPSITE TOILETS
