

Fig. 3. Total coverage of Department of Conservation records of frogs by 10000 yard grid squares for the North Island.

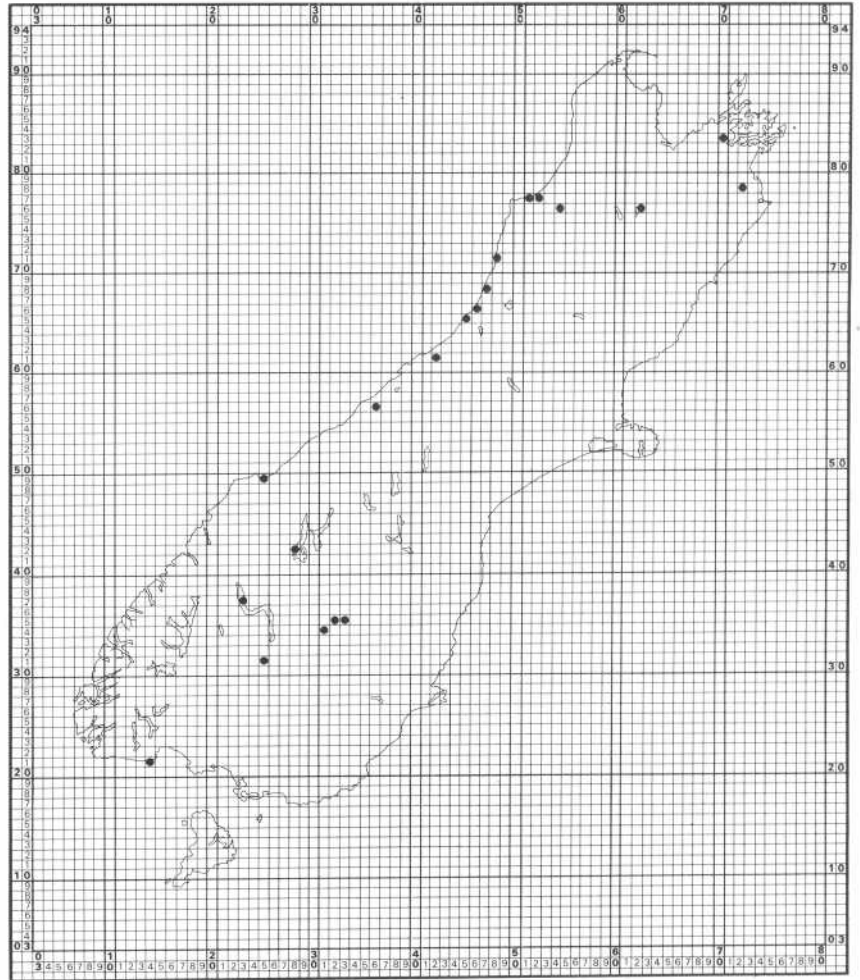


Fig. 4. Total coverage of Department of Conservation records of frogs by 10000 yard grid squares for the South Island.

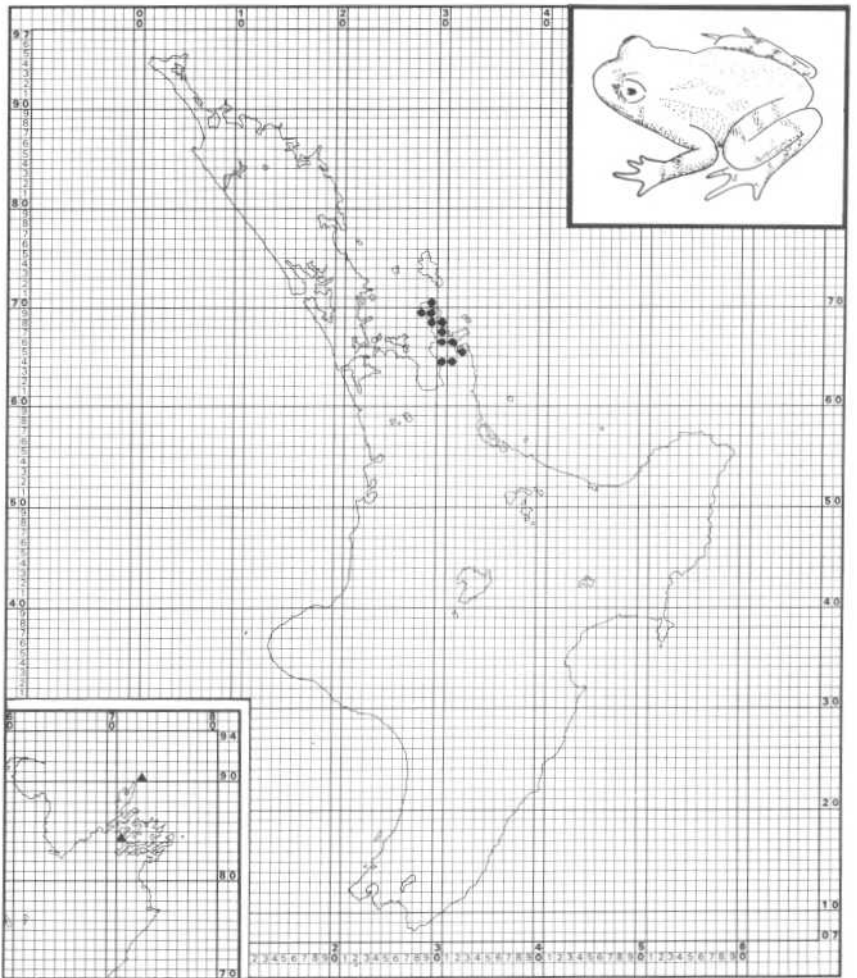


Fig. 5. Distribution records for the native frogs *Leiopelma archeyi* (circles) and *L. hamiltoni* (triangles) (after Bell 1982).

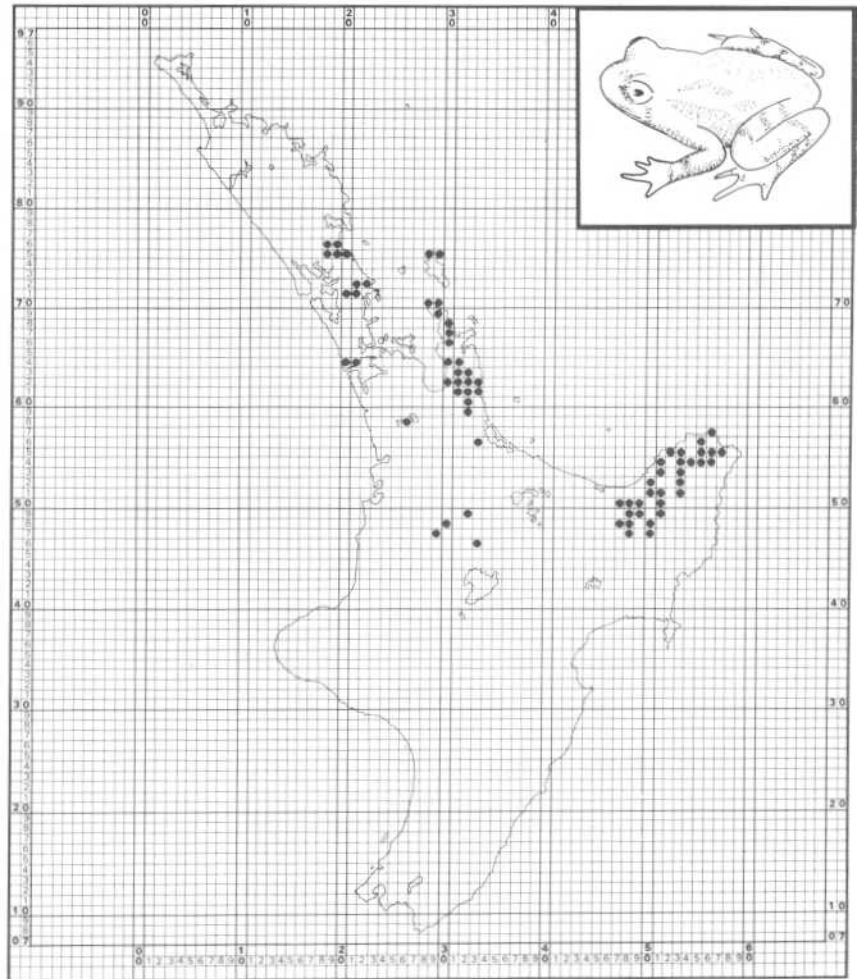


Fig. 6. Distribution records for the native frog *Leiopelma hochstetteri* (after Bell 1982).

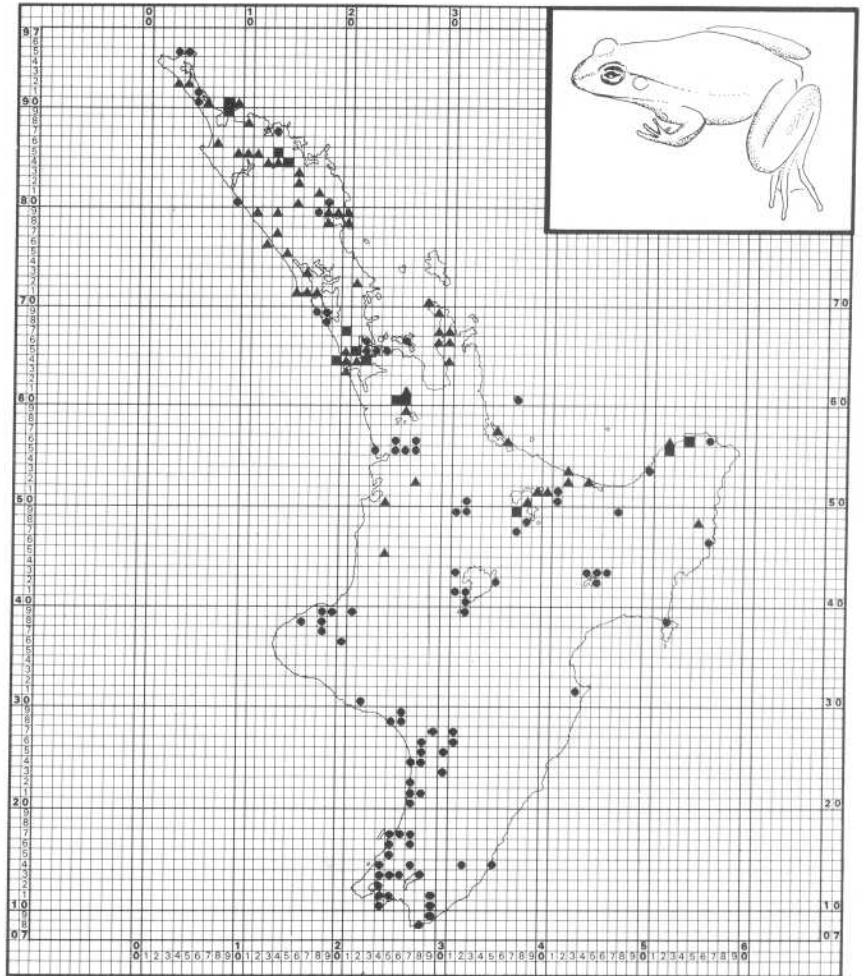


Fig. 7. Distribution records for the introduced frogs *Litoria aurea* (triangles) and *L. raniformis* (circles) in the North Island, with squares representing sites with both species (after Bell 1982).
